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Abstract

Bilingualism is a pervading sociolinguistic phenomenon that has characterized Algeria for many decades. Indeed, along with Arabic, French continues to be used in various domains such as administration, education and particularly in some streams of higher education. In Belhadj Bouchaib university centre of Ain-Temouchent, researcher aimed at investigating such phenomenon among students studying in the department of biology.
